EarlyEd mobile playgroup is for families living in Auburn/Holroyd who have a child aged 0 - 5, and are concerned about a delay in their child's development, or are on a waiting list for early childhood intervention services.

EarlyEd early childhood intervention mobile playgroup is run by an early childhood special educator together with members of the EarlyEd therapy team. We also have a language support worker and access to interpreters.

They can help you learn about:

- ways to help your child learn to walk or talk
- managing your child's behaviour
- playing with your child to help them learn
- other services to help your child
