## **Services to Schools**

Services can include support for individual students, training, workshops, family support, coaching, transition planning and resource development.



## Ready for Learning

EarlyEd's Ready for Learning approach is:

#### Holistic

Most children with delays in development experience difficulty learning and therefore benefit from a team approach that considers the needs of the whole child.

#### Collaborative

By working in partnership with the EarlyEd team, the needs and requirements of the child, school and home are recognised by offering support that is responsive and flexible.

### Capacity building

By sharing knowledge and problem solving together, the EarlyEd team finds ways to support a child's development

and readiness for learning.



## EarlyEd Team expertise

When engaging with EarlyEd, schools have access to a team of early intervention staff with specialised expertise and experience across all disciplines.

The EarlyEd team includes speech pathologists, special educators, occupational therapists, physiotherapists and behaviour specialists, working together to offer a holistic approach to intervention support.

Schools are able to request support from a specific discipline knowing that EarlyEd staff:

- Have access to advice and supervision from other disciplines.
- Are experienced transdisciplinary interventionists with extra training and broad skill sets across all areas of development and learning.


