RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR EARLYED FAMILIES



EARLYED'S RESPONSIBILITIES	
WHEN YOU RECEIVE SERVICES DELIVERED BY EARLYED STAFF YOU AND YOUR CHILD HAVE THE RIGHT TO:	
RESPECT, DIGNITY PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY	 be treated with respect and dignity privacy and confidentiality at all times. Consent is obtained to store and exchange data. be supported to develop your own identity and independence
EQUALITY	 receive services free from discrimination, abuse, neglect and exploitation have your individual culture, language, personal values, needs and health and wellbeing recognised
INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT	receive services based on the individual needs and goals of your child and family
INFORMATION	 access EarlyEd's policies and procedures receive information in the best way for you use interpreters if you need them and have material translated receive all the information you need be able to easily understand the information you receive
GIVE FEEDBACK OR COMPLAIN	be supported to give feedback and make complaints know that concerns will be listened to and addressed
QUALITY	 know that EarlyEd follows all legal requirements receive services that are the best practice in early intervention be supported to provide the best early intervention for your child
CHOICE	 manage all planning and delivery of your services make informed decisions and service choices have choices about services eg when, how and where they are delivered use other services, change services and leave EarlyEd when you want to receive support when you want it
INCLUSION	be included in family and community and find new opportunities and activities
SAFETY	know that all environments are safe and child safe practices are used
GOOD RECORDS	 monitoring and documenting of your child's progress access to records and information about your child
ADVOCACY	be supported to use an advocate if and when you want to advocate for your child and family
INVOLVEMENT	 receive services as agreed to (costs and conditions outlined) and adjusted on request be involved in developing EarlyEd services

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

When you are receiving services from EarlyEd you will be responsible for:

- respecting all the children, families, staff and property of EarlyEd
- keeping staff up to date with information about your child as it will help with their early intervention
- joining in with your child's early intervention services
