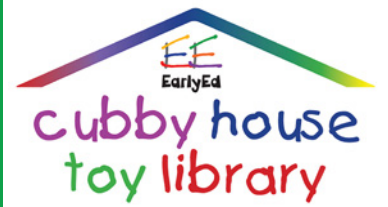


Play and Engage

JUST RIGHT

When your play is “just right” for them it will keep them interested.

To be “just right” think about

- how to help them sit, stand and move to make the play easier or more challenging
- reducing the number of toys or bringing in new ones.

- looking at what your child is interested in,
- being animated,
- varying your voice and
- creating fun and surprise.
